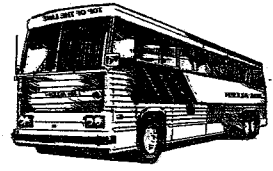

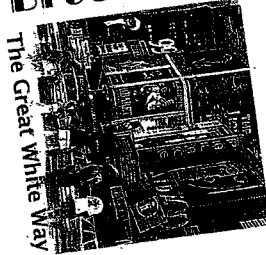

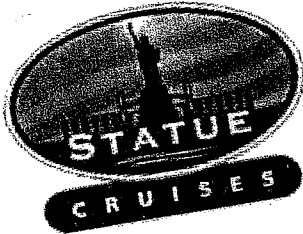

#### DAY ONE – SUNDAY – APRIL 25, 2010

We will depart Ashley Landing Mall at 6:45 AM for the first day of our wonderful New York in the Spring tour. Today we will travel to Fredericksburg, VA for our first nights stay. After arrival and check-in you will have time to freshen up before our "Welcome" dinner, included. (DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

#### DAY FOUR – WEDNESDAY – APRIL 28, 2010

Get ready for a busy day! We will meet our step-on guide at the hotel this morning for a full day of touring and shopping. We will visit all of the interesting places both Uptown and Downtown, Cathedrals, Fifth Avenue, Central Park, Trump Tower, FOA Schwartz, Rockefeller Center, Wall Street, Lincoln Center and much more. and then continue our tour. We will return to our hotel to freshen up before departing for another fabulous dinner on TOL at "Hurley's". This NYC historical landmark in the heart of the Theatre District has been serving food since 1892. After dinner we have reserved seating for another wonderful Broadway Production (TBA). #### DAY FIVE – THURSDAY – APRIL 29, 2010

Regretfully, we must leave New York City behind and depart for another exciting destination. Our first stop today will be at West Point US Military Academy. Our guide will tell us the story of West Point, its role in the Revolution, its famous history along with stories about graduates who shaped our nation.
