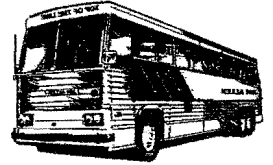

PARRIS ISLAND TOUR BEAUFORT, SC Thursday APRIL 15, 2010



We will leave Ashley Landing Mall at 7:15 AM for this wonderful day trip to Parris Island, South Carolina. Five miles south of Historic Beaufort, SC is Parris Island. It is named after Alexander Parris who purchased it in 1715. It has a rich history dating back to the mid-1500's when Spanish and French explorers clashed on the Island's shores as they sought a strategic foothold in the New World. Today, it is one of the main recruit training stations for the United States Marine Corp. The U.S. Marine Corps has occupied Parris Island since 1915. Under the watchful eyes of the Drill instructors, some 20,000 men and 2,000 women complete their training at Parris Island each year. Highlights of your visit will be the Iwo Jima Monument, Parade Field, and the Marine Museum. The museum was listed in the top twenty visitor attractions in South Carolina. Upon arrival in Beaufort we will stop at the Beaufort Welcome Center to meet our tour guide and give you a short break. We will depart for Parris Island and tour the Historic district called "Mainsides." After our driving tour you will have time to tour the Marine Museum before having lunch, on TOL, at "Traditions Restaurant" – The Club aboard Parris Island which remains a

“tradition” for gatherings of Marines of all ranks. After lunch, we will depart for Historic Downtown Beaufort and give you some time to explore on your own. Before departing for Charleston we will make a brief stop at “The Chocolate Tree” for treats! We should arrive back in Charleston around 5:00 PM.
