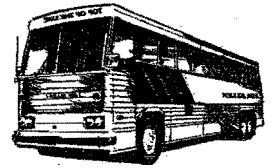

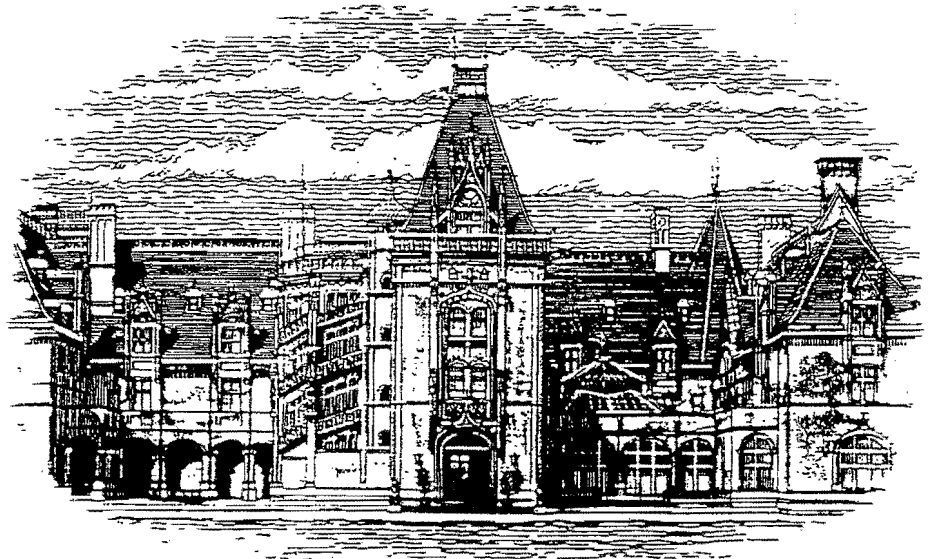


Biltmore Estate @ Christmas

DAY ONE - THURSDAY - DECEMBER 27, 2012

We will depart Ashley Landing Mall this morning at 6:45 AM with a pickup in Summerville for our annual journey to Asheville to see the Biltmore decorated for Christmas. There will be rest stops and lunch, on TOTL, en route to Asheville. Asheville is one of the most popular mountain resorts in the East and is also one of the top 10 places to live. It is divided by two rivers, the Swannonoa and the French Broad, and is surrounded by the Great Smoky Mountains and the Blue Ridge Mountains. Upon arrival we will drop our luggage off at the Holiday Inn Express and Suites before we leave for an afternoon of sightseeing and some shopping. If weather permits, we will drive part of the Blue Ridge Parkway (this time of the year sometimes the park is closed due to ice). We will also visit the Grove Park Inn and give you time to see the Ginger Bread Houses on display that are part of the annual competition that is held here each year. We will return to the hotel to freshen up before departing for dinner at the Stone Ridge Tavern. (LUNCH AND DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY TWO - FRIDAY- DECEMBER 28, 2012

Enjoy a hot breakfast buffet at the hotel before will check out and head to the Biltmore Estates. We will arrive at the Biltmore just as they open so that we will have plenty of time to tour the house. Christmas at the Biltmore is more exquisite than you could imagine. They use decorations that fit the time period of the house. There are more than 35 trees, hundreds of wreaths and poinsettias and 10,000 feet of evergreen swags throughout the house. We have 12:00 pm reservations for lunch, included, at the Deerpark Inn. We will enjoy a wonderful holiday buffet lunch. After lunch we will visit the winery and see how the award winning wines are made. There is complimentary wine tasting and a gift shop for purchases. We will leave for home after visiting the winery. We should arrive back in Charleston around 6:30 PM. (BREAKFAST AND LUNCH INCLUDED TODAY)
