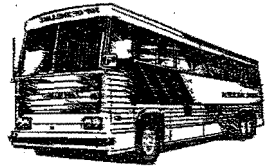

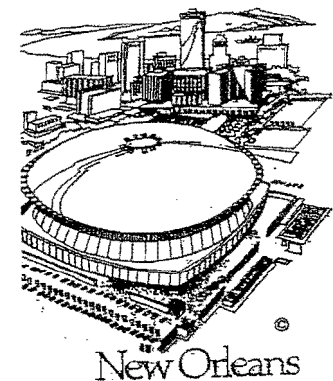
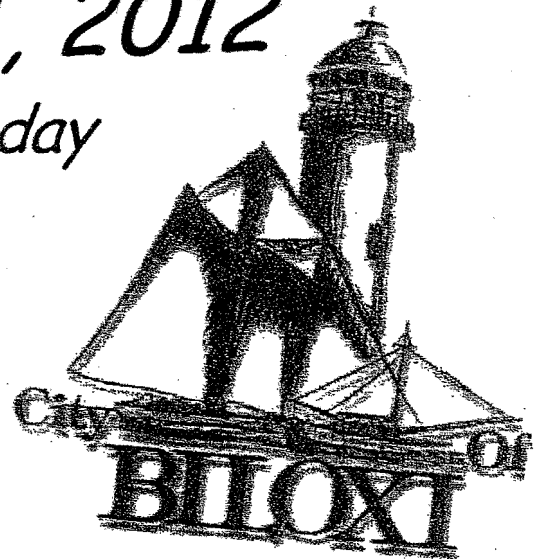

DAY ONE – SATURDAY – FEBRUARY 25, 2012

Depart Ashley Landing this morning at 5:45 AM for our Biloxi and New Orleans tour with a pick-up in Summerville at 6:00 AM. Our travels today will take us across the state of Georgia and into Alabama. There will be rest stops and lunch, on own, enroute. Our first night will be spent in Birmingham, AL. After check-in you will have time to freshen up before enjoying our “Welcome” dinner at the hotel on TOTL. (DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY TWO – SUNDAY – FEBRUARY 26, 2012

After breakfast at the hotel this morning on TOL, we will checkout and head for Biloxi, Mississippi to the beautifully restored “Beau Rivage Resort and Casino Hotel”, our home for the next three nights. Immerse yourself in the casual elegance and unrivaled hospitality of the Mississippi Gulf Coast’s premiere entertainment resort. After check-in, the rest of the day and evening are yours to explore this extraordinary resort. Relax in the pool, do some shopping or try your hand at “lady luck” in the casino. Upon check-in you will be given (2) breakfast buffet coupons and (1) dinner buffet coupon to use as you please during your stay. (BREAKFAST AND DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY THREE – MONDAY – FEBRUARY 27, 2012

This morning after breakfast, we will depart at 9:00 AM for a day of sightseeing in New Orleans, Louisiana. Upon arrival in New Orleans you will have some free time to explore and have lunch, on your own, before we meet our step-on guide for a tour of this fabled city. Our tour will include the French Quarter, historic Esplanade Ave, St. Louis Cemetery, Lake Ponchartrain, plus much more. Once again we will see some of the destruction wrought by Hurricane Katrina and the on-going efforts to restore this historic city to its original state. After the tour we journey back to Biloxi where the rest of the afternoon and evening are free. (BREAKFAST INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY FOUR – TUESDAY – FEBRUARY 28, 2012

Today, after breakfast, our step-on guide will meet our coach at the hotel. We will spend the morning touring the Biloxi and Gulf Coast area so that you can see first hand the devastation left by Hurricane Katrina and the amazing clean-up efforts that are still on going. Much of the area has been restored and re-opened to the public. We will see the Biloxi Lighthouse, Point Graduate and visit Camp Katrina if it is still open when we are visiting. We will return to the hotel in time for lunch, on your own and the rest of the day free to do as you please. (BREAKFAST INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY FIVE – WEDNESDAY – FEBRUARY 29, 2012

Regretfully, after breakfast on your own, we must checkout and start our journey back to Charleston. Today we head for Callaway Gardens, GA for our last night out. There will be rest stops and lunch, on own, en route. Upon arrival we will pick up our guide for a driving tour of the gardens. Founded in 1952 by industrialist Cason J. Callaway, the gardens feature beautiful horticultural displays and miles of scenic woodland drives. Also included in the tour are the Ida Cason Callaway Memorial Chapel, the Virginia Hand Callaway Discovery Center and the Cecil B. Day Butterfly Center. After checking in and freshening up, we will enjoy dinner at the hotel on TOTL. (DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY SIX – THURSDAY – MARCH 1, 2012

After breakfast at the hotel, we check out and depart for home. There will be rest stops en route and lunch on TOTL in Social Circle, Georgia at one of our most favorite places to eat – The Blue Willow

Inn". After lunch we depart for Charleston. We should arrive back in Charleston around 6:00 PM.

In the event of cancellation by TOP OF THE LINE TOURS, all monies paid will be refunded in full.

TOP OF THE LINE TOURS reserves the right to cancel any tour for conditions beyond our control, including insufficient participation, and to change or modify the itinerary as may be necessary for completion of a tour or for the safety of our passengers. We reserve the right to accept or reject any person as a member of our tour at any time. It is our intention to provide congenial traveling companions. Thus, we reserve the right to take individuals off trips at any point if said person disrupts the tour for others. The balance of that person's tour would be refunded.
