**DAY THREE - MONDAY - JANUARY 17, 2011**

Today will be spent at sea. Spend the day exploring this beautiful ship and enjoying all of the amenities on board. (ONBOARD SNACKS AND MEALS TODAY)

**DAY FOUR - TUESDAY - JANUARY 18, 2011**

Today we dock in Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands. Grand Cayman, kissed by sparkling turquoise waters, is a dream come true for water sports enthusiasts. You can snorkel with stingrays, go scuba diving, sail a catamaran, take in some sport fishing, or just mellow out along the powder soft sand of the magnificent Seven Mile Beach. While you're there, don't forget to visit Hell, which is devilishly popular with senders of postcards! Take a submarine ride and marvel at colorful coral landscapes teeming with marine life, or you may prefer to see the view through a glass-bottomed boat. Of course, there is plenty of shopping available. Be sure to return to the ship in time for the 4:00 PM sailing. (ONBOARD MEALS AND SNACKS INCLUDED TODAY)

#### **DAY FIVE - WEDNESDAY - JANUARY 19, 2011**

You can sleep in this morning. We arrive in Cozumel, Mexico around 10:00 AM. Long before Cancun became a popular destination, Cozumel was well known as a diving spot and home to the world famous Palancar Reef. Non-divers can kick back on a sun-drenched beach or enjoy any number of seaside activities, such as shopping in colorful marketplaces or dining in an open-air café. Cozumel is located just off the coast of the Yucatan Peninsula. Cozumel has done much to retain its Mexican character. You may want to take an excursion inland to visit the great pyramids and temples of the Mayas. Be back on board in time for a 6:00 PM sailing. (ONBOARD MEALS AND SNACKS INCLUDED TODAY)

#### **DAY SIX - THURSDAY - JANUARY 20, 2011**

Today finds us in the port city of Belize City. The longest barrier reef in the Western Hemisphere fringes Belize City, which makes snorkeling and scuba diving extremely popular here. Recreational pursuits are popular, ranging from inner-tube trips down a jungle river to zip-line tours amid the treetops of a rain forest. Other tours departing from the Central American city visit Mayan ruins, wildlife preserves and botanical gardens, or spend the day at a pristine beach or browsing the delights of Belize City, including its marketplace, cathedrals and restored colonial mansions. Be back onboard in time for a 5:00 PM sailing. (ONBOARD SNACKS AND MEALS INCLUDED TODAY)

#### **DAY SEVEN - FRIDAY - JANUARY 21, 2011**

This morning we find ourselves in - Isla Roatan. Floating 30 miles off the Caribbean coastline of Honduras, in the Bay Islands, Roatan is 29 miles long and two miles wide. With a warm climate of around 80 degrees, you can lounge on the island's white sand beaches or snorkel in the crystal blue waters. You may spot some of the wildlife indigenous to the island, such as the Red Lored Parrot, the Lala Monkey or the Jesus Lizard, so named for its ability to "walk on water". Our cruise consultant says that Roatan has some of the best shopping, especially the hand-woven bedspreads. Return to the ship in time for a 3:00 PM sailing. (ONBOARD SNACKS AND MEALS INCLUDED TODAY)

#### **DAY EIGHT - SATURDAY - JANUARY 22, 2011**

Today will be spent at sea. Relax and catch up on your rest after all the exciting port of calls that we have visited. (ONBOARD SNACKS AND MEALS TODAY)

#### **DAY NINE - SUNDAY - JANUARY 23, 2011**

Sadly our wonderful cruise must come to an end. We arrive back in Port of Tampa this morning. We will be on the road to Charleston as soon as we are able to get off the ship and loaded on the bus. There will be rest stops and meals stops en route to Charleston as needed. We should arrive back home around 7:00 PM. (ONBOARD BREAKFAST INCLUDED PRIOR TO DISEMBARKATION)

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** The cancellation policy of Carnival Cruise Lines and Top of the Line Tours will apply as follows:

76 or more days prior to sailing date – full refund of monies paid

70 to 30 days prior to sailing date – refund of amount paid less cruise line penalty, cost of insurance premiums and any monies paid out and not refunded to Top of the Line Tours. Must file insurance claim to receive refund of unrefunded portion.

29 to 8 days prior to sailing date – 50% of total cruise fare (less port & government fees) will be refunded by Carnival. Must file insurance claim for the remaining portion of the cruise fare, plus any monies paid to Top of the Line Tours for lodging, meals, portage, motorcoach transportation, insurance premiums and administrative expenses. Must file insurance claim to receive a refund of unrefunded portion.

7 days or less – 100% of total fare penalty. Must file insurance claim for refund.

In the event of cancellation by Top of the Line Tours, all monies paid will be refunded in full.

TOP OF THE LINE TOURS reserves the right to cancel any tour for conditions beyond our control, including insufficient participation, and to change or modify the itinerary as may be necessary for completion of a tour or for the safety of our passengers. We reserve the right to accept or reject any person as a member of our tour at any time. It is our intention to provide congenial traveling companions. Thus, we reserve the right to take individuals off trips at any point if said person disrupts the tour for others. The balance of that person’s tour would be refunded.
