

Tunica ~ Tennessee ~ Fitz Casino

DAY ONE – TUESDAY – JULY 27, 2010

We will depart Ashley Landing Mall at 5:45 AM with a pick up in Summerville to begin our exciting Tennessee and Mississippi adventure. Our first day's journey takes us to Hurricane Mills, Tennessee. Lunch will be on TOL at The Old Country Store Restaurant. After lunch our journey takes us to Tunica, Mississippi for a two-night stay at the fabulous Fitz Casino and Hotel. After checking into the hotel you will be free to see the sights around the hotel and try your hand with "Lady Luck" in the Casino. DAY THREE – THURSDAY – JULY 29, 2010

Breakfast buffet is included this morning at your leisure. We will depart the hotel at 1:30 PM to walk over to the dock (transportation will be provided for those unable to walk) for the "Tunica Queen Riverboat" located behind the hotel at the River Park. After our river boat tour the rest of the day and evening are yours to explore the new Tunica River Park. This eco-park offers a learning experience like no other in the US. An ecology trail, outdoor observation deck and rocking chairs provide relaxing ways to view the river. Of course, you can also try your "LUCK" at the casino in the hotel or take a shuttle to one of the many casinos in the Tunica area. You will have a coupon to enjoy the buffet dinner at your leisure. DAY FOUR – FRIDAY – JULY 30, 2010

Enjoy a buffet breakfast this morning before checking out and departing for Crossville, Tennessee. There will be rest stops and lunch, on own, en route. We will then depart for the Cumberland County Playhouse to help them celebrate their 45th year. Our show tonight will be “Tennessee USA”. This “Musical Comedy Cavalcade” of Tennessee history opened the new Cumberland County Playhouse in 1965 and has been seen by over a quarter million people. Now all the tradition and spectacle of Tennessee’s stirring, flag-waving musical hit has returned to the Playhouse stage in an exciting New Millennium production!
