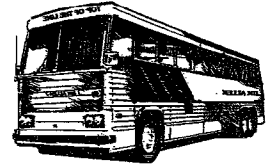

DAY ONE – TUESDAY – JUNE 5, 2012

We will depart Ashley Landing at 7:00 AM, with a pick-up in Summerville at 7:15 AM. Today we travel to Colonial Williamsburg, VA for a 3-night stay at the Williamsburg Woodlands Hotel & Suites. One of the official Colonial Williamsburg hotels that is just a short stroll to the Historic Area. Our hotel features impeccable service, modern amenities and recreational activities. After checking into our hotel, we will have time to freshen up before boarding the coach and departing for dinner, on TOL. (DINNER INCLUDED)

DAY TWO – WEDNESDAY – JUNE 6, 2012

After a deluxe continental breakfast buffet, we have passes to Colonial Williamsburg. These passes gives you the freedom, flexibility and convenience to enjoy the Colonial Williamsburg experience for the length of our stay. This pass allows access to all daytime programs, museums, exhibition sites, and Revolutionary City. You are at your leisure today to explore, shop and enjoy lunch on your own. You may return to the hotel and return to return to the park at any time. This evening we have reservation for dinner at Shield's Tavern. In the early 1740s, James Shields assumed proprietorship of Shields Tavern that his father-in-law had operated several decades earlier. There's nothing like a candlelit dinner in an 18th century tavern to take you away from the present time. Costumed wait staff will bid you welcome, and wandering balladeers may serenade you. Tavern guests will dine on southern comfort foods inspired by "colonial receipts". (CONTINENTAL BREAKFAST AND DINNER INCLUDED)

DAY THREE – THURSDAY – JUNE 7, 2012

After a deluxe continental breakfast buffet, we will board the coach and depart for Busch Gardens. This 100-acre European theme adventure park celebrates the cultures of England, Scotland, France, Germany, Italy and Ireland. You are free to explore this site. After a full day of adventures, we will board the coach and return to our hotel. (CONTINENTAL BREAKFAST INCLUDED)

DAY FOUR – FRIDAY – JUNE 8, 2012

In the event of cancellation by TOP OF THE LINE TOURS, all monies paid will be refunded in full.

TOP OF THE LINE TOURS reserves the right to cancel any tour for conditions beyond our control, including insufficient participation, and to change or modify the itinerary as may be necessary for completion of a tour or for the safety of our passengers. We reserve the right to accept or reject any person as a member of our tour at any time. It is our intention to provide congenial traveling companions. Thus, we reserve the right to take individuals off trips at any point if said person disrupts the tour for others. The balance of that person's tour would be refunded.
