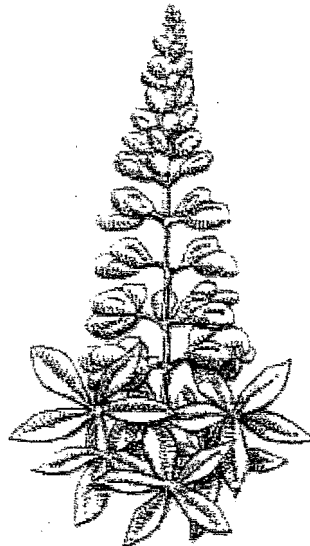
TEXAS ON ★ TOUR

DAY ONE – TUESDAY – MARCH 13, 2012

We will depart Ashley Landing this morning at 5:45 A.M. as we begin our Texas tour traveling across Georgia and into Mississippi. After checking into our hotel in Meridian, Ms we will have time to freshen up and relax before dinner on TOL at hotel. (Dinner included today)

DAY TWO – WEDNESDAY –MARCH 14, 2012

Lunch, on TOL, will be at the Magnolia Café. We will then depart the gardens for Columbus, GA, where we will check into our hotel. We will have time to freshen up before dinner on TOL. (Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner included today)

DAY EIGHT – TUESDAY – MARCH 20, 2012

Enjoy the continental breakfast in the hotel before we check out and depart for our tour of Ft. Benning home of the infantry. At Ft. Benning men are transform into soldiers.
