Historic Thomasville & Bainbridge, Georgia

DAY ONE – TUESDAY – MARCH 16, 2010

We will depart Ashley Landing at 6:00 A.M to begin our tour of southern Georgia. Today we will travel to Thomasville, GA. From its beginning the area's rich land permitted the formation of a classic old South society, a plantation economy based on cotton. During the Civil War, Thomasville played an important role in the Confederate cause by supplying goods and men. During the 1800's the city became a winter resort of national and international fame. Some of the most luxuriously appointed hotels of America's gilded age were located in Thomasville, "the Original Winter Resort of the South". Many of these buildings have been restored and are open to the public for tours. We will be able to visit several of these while we are here. We will have a guided tour of the historic area before we check in to our hotel. After the tour we will have dinner at a Seafood House in the downtown area. (Dinner included)

DAY TWO – WEDNESDAY – MARCH 17, 2010

Breakfast is available in the hotel before we leave for a tour of one of the most amazing and captivating plantation houses, Pebble Hill. It is the only one of its kind open to the public. It covers over 3,000 acres and the main house has 40 rooms. You may also visit the carriage and auto museum. After the tour we will have a box lunch on the picnic grounds of the plantation. We will drive the short distance to Bainbridge, GA, where we will spend the night. Before checking in at the hotel we will have a step on guide join us for a tour of this historic town. The Seminole Indians thrived on the bluffs of the Flint River here before deSoto set foot in Georgia in 1540. Generations of Southerners have seen the evolution of this magnificent landscape-rich with Indian lore, scarred by battle, and blessed with beautifully preserved monuments honoring these life changes. After our tour we will have a seafood dinner at Wingate's Lodge and Marina located on the banks of Lake Seminole. (Breakfast, lunch and dinner included)

DAY THREE – THURSDAY – MARCH 18, 2010

After breakfast in the hotel we will head home to Charleston. We will have rest stops en route, and lunch, on your own, before arrival. We should return to Charleston around 5:00 P.M. (Breakfast included)
