DAY ONE – WEDNESDAY – MARCH 3, 2010

We will depart Ashley Landing this morning at 6:30 A.M. as we begin our Texas tour. Traveling across Georgia and into Alabama, we will overnight in Bessemer, AL, on the outskirts of Birmingham. Birmingham is Alabama's largest city and one of its youngest. Once known for Iron and steel, its top industries now include medicine, engineering, education, finance, and technology. The city's largest single employer is the University of Alabama. Health care involves one out of every ten people. After check in at the hotel we will have dinner at the Santa Fe Cattle Co. Restaurant. (Dinner included)

DAY TWO – THURSDAY – MARCH 4, 2010

Tyler, Texas is our destination today. After breakfast at the hotel we will travel to Vicksburg, MS, for a guided tour of the downtown area. After lunch, on own, we will continue on to Tyler, This city is the rose capital of Texas. There are over 38,000 rose bushes representing 500 varieties blooming among 14 acres of tall pines, ponds, fountains and reflecting pools in their municipal gardens. (Breakfast included).

DAY THREE – FRIDAY – MARCH 5, 2010

Have breakfast in the hotel before we tour the rose gardens. We will then travel to Waco, TX, where we will tour the Dr. Pepper Museum, and The Texas Ranger's Hall of Fame. We will then check in at the hotel. Modern Waco is the largest marketing center between Dallas and Austin; its economy focuses on diversified industry, agriculture, and education. Baylor University is the oldest university in the state and the largest Baptist University in the world. (Breakfast included)

DAY FOUR – SATURDAY – MARCH 6, 2010

Enjoy a full hot breakfast in the hotel this morning. On our way to San Antonio, where we will spend two nights, we will tour the LBJ Museum and State Historic Site in Johnson City, TX. as well as tour the LBJ Ranch. After lunch, on own, we will continue on to San Antonio, TX. Our hotel is located on the Riverwalk, one of the city's premier assets covering 2.5 miles along the San Antonio River. You may want to stroll along the banks of the riverwalk, take a boat ride on the river, or enjoy the many shops and restaurants located here. (Breakfast included)

DAY FIVE – SUNDAY – MARCH 7, 2010

After a full hot breakfast in the hotel we will be joined by a step-on-guide for a four-hour tour of the city. We will visit one of the missions, and give you an overview of the city and surrounding area. After the tour your day is free to explore the city and visit some of the attractions we saw on the tour. Don't forget the Alamo and Market Square. There are several Shopping Malls adjoining the Riverwalk. (Breakfast included)

DAY SIX – MONDAY – MARCH 8, 2010

Have breakfast in the hotel before an early departure for Houston, TX. On arrival in Houston, we will visit NASA's Johnson Space Center. You can try on space helmets, touch a moon rock and climb aboard computer simulators to retrieve a satellite, land the space shuttle and walk on the moon. You can also see the Mercury, Gemini, and Apollo Capsules. After leaving the Space Center, we will drive to Galveston, TX, meet out step on guide and tour this beautiful island off Houston's coast. There is a 36 block district offering more than 100 shops, restaurants, and

galleries housed in Victorian buildings. There are lovely Victorian houses, nostalgic gaslights and horse drawn carriages clip clopping along the historic Strand. We will also see what has been done to reclaim the area damaged from the last devastating hurricane After the tour we will stop for dinner, on own, before checking in at our hotel close to the space center. (Breakfast included)

DAY SEVEN – TUESDAY – MARCH 9, 2010

Enjoy a deluxe Continental breakfast in the hotel this morning. Our travels today take up through Louisiana and into Mississippi. We are staying tonight in the beautiful Beau Rivage Casino Hotel in Biloxi, MS. You will have vouchers for dinner and breakfast buffets in the hotel restaurant. Enjoy the wonderful ambience of the hotel, visit the interesting shops, or try you luck in the casino this evening. (Breakfast & Dinner included)

DAY EIGHT – WEDNESDAY – MARCH 10, 2010

Enjoy the great breakfast buffet in the hotel before we leave for Pine Mountain, Georgia. We will stay in the Mountain Creek Inn at Calloway Gardens. Founded in 1952 by industrialist Cason J. Calloway, the park features beautiful horticultural displays and miles of scenic woodland drives. The gardens cover 13,000 acres in the foothills of the Appalachians. After a tour of the gardens, we will enjoy a dinner buffet in the Plant Room, a real treat. (Breakfast and dinner included)

DAY NINE – THURSDAY – MARCH 11, 2010

The breakfast buffet will be served in the Plant Room where we had dinner last evening. We will depart for home after breakfast, stopping in the town of SocialCircle, Georgia, for lunch in the renowned Blue Willow Inn. This restaurant has been rated among the top 10 restaurants in the southeast for many years. Don't forget to try the fried green tomatoes, one of their many specialties. You will have time for browsing in the delightful gift shop there before we head home. We should arrive back in Charleston around 6:30 P.M. (Breakfast & lunch included)
