DAY ONE – WEDNESDAY – MAY 12, 2010

We depart Ashley Landing Mall at 5:45 A.M. to begin our TULIP TIME TOUR to Niagara Falls and Ottawa, Ontario, Canada. Our first night will be spent in one of our favorite hotels in Sutton, West Virginia. This hotel has won the award as the best hotel and convention center in West Virginia for many years. En route we will have rest stops and lunch, on your own. We will stop by the Visitor Center at the New River Gorge to give you an opportunity to see this spectacular place and enjoy a film about the area before arriving at the hotel. After check in you will have time to rest and freshen up before dinner. I am sure you will enjoy the delicious meal they prepare for us. (Dinner included)

DAY TWO – THURSDAY – MAY 13, 2010

A wonderful breakfast will be prepared for us this morning before we depart for Niagara Falls. On the way we will drive you through Morgantown, WV, to show you their innovative transportation system serving the downtown area and the University. We will have rest stops and lunch, on your own, as we travel. You will enjoy the scenery through Pennsylvania and New York State. After check in at the hotel for a two night stay, you will have time to visit the Falls and do some shopping in the city or visit the Casino just a block from the hotel which is on the main thoroughfare. DAY THREE – FRIDAY – MAY 14, 2010

Continental breakfast available at hotel this morning.

This morning we will tour the area, including the Botanical Gardens, home to their school of horticulture, the Floral Clock, the lovely city of Niagara on the Lake where you will have time to shop and have lunch, and stop at a fruit stand in the area featuring home grown fruits of every variety. We will visit the Aero Car and let you take a ride across the reversing falls if you desire. This is a thrilling experience. After our return to the hotel you will have free time to rest, shop, visit the falls, a block away, or ride the Maid of the Mist boat for a closer look at the falls. Be sure you get back to the hotel in time to change for our delightful evening, dinner at the Minolta Tower and a view of the lights on the falls at dusk. (Continental Breakfast & Dinner included)

DAY FOUR – SATURDAY – MAY 15, 2010

Continental breakfast this morning at hotel prior to departure.

Regretfully, we must leave Niagara Falls and journey to Ottawa – Canada's capital city. A city (much like our own capital) that is unspoiled by industry, regal in appearance, and awash in its country's history. With over 70 municipal parks, stately tree-lined streets, and an abundance of noble monuments, Ottawa epitomizes a dignified capital and justly represents all that is Canada. We will have rest stops and lunch, on your own, en route. We should arrive early in the early afternoon which will give you time to explore this lovely city. Our hotel is designed in the same format as the Parliament building and is located in the middle of the downtown area and very close to a large shopping mall. Enjoy your afternoon and evening free. (Continental Breakfast)

DAY FIVE – SUNDAY – MAY 16, 2010

Breakfast is on your own this morning. There is a restaurant and a coffee shop in our hotel. We will be met by a step-on guide who will take us through the many acres of tulips in this great city. Queen Juliana of Holland sends millions of tulip bulbs here each year in appreciation for the refuge Ottawa gave her when she was expecting one of her children during World War II and had to flee the Nazi occupation of her homeland. We will see many of the residences,

Parliament buildings, embassies, and beautiful gardens throughout the city and learn many interesting facts about Ottawa. After we return to the hotel, your afternoon and evening are free. (All meals on own today)

DAY SIX – MONDAY – MAY 17, 2010

Breakfast is on your own this morning before we check out and start making our way towards home. This morning we will make our way to the gorgeous Thousand Islands region to Gananoque, a resort town that is literally the gateway to the 1000 Islands. Get a breathtaking view of the Canadian 1000 Islands as we cruise on the St. Lawrence River. World famous Boldt Castle on Heart Island is one of the many spectacular things you'll see today. We will have lunch, on own, before boarding the boat or food is available on the boat. After our boat tour we will continue on to Binghamton, NY for a one-night stay. Dinner tonight will be on your own. (All meals on own today)

DAY SEVEN – TUESDAY – MAY 18, 2010

A continental breakfast is available at the hotel this morning before we check out and travel south to Fredericksburg, VA for a one-night stay. We will have rest stops and lunch, on own, en route. After checking in and freshening up dinner will be at the hotel tonight on TOL. (Continental breakfast & Dinner included today)

DAY EIGHT – WEDNESDAY – MAY 19, 2010

A full breakfast is available at the hotel this morning on TOL. We will check out and complete our journey home. The dogwood trees should be in bloom as we travel through North Carolina and into South Carolina. There will be rest stops and lunch, on own, en route. We should arrive back in Charleston around 6:00 PM with fond memories of this wonderful Tulip Time Trip to Canada. (Breakfast included today)
