



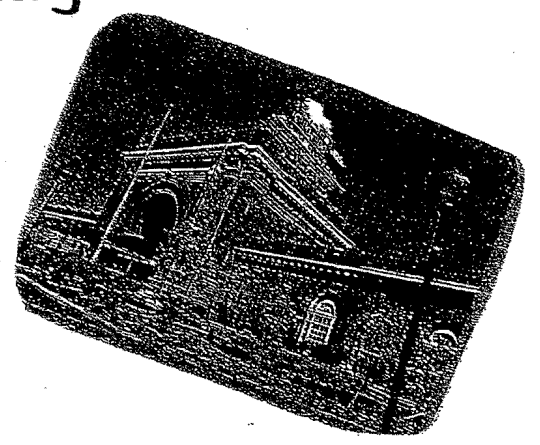
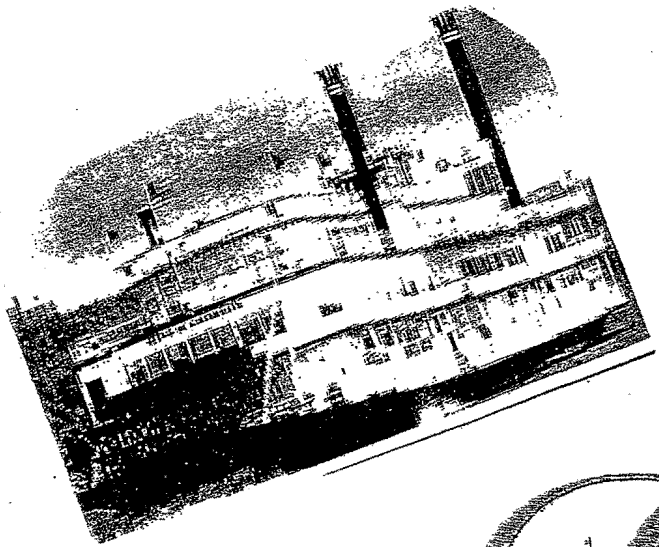

DAY ONE - SUNDAY - MAY 20, 2012

We will leave Ashley Landing Mall at 6:45 AM this morning for Chattanooga, TN for our one-night stay. There will be rest stops and lunch, on own. The weather should be pleasant and the scenery beautiful. This afternoon we will check in at the Chattanooga Choo Choo. Built around the historic 1909 train station and listed on the National Register for Historic Preservation, the Chattanooga Choo Choo covers 24 acres. It combines the luxuries of today with the memories of a bygone era. After check in you will have time to explore or relax before departing for dinner. This evening we will have dinner and a cruise on the Tennessee River aboard the Southern Belle Riverboat. The Admiral's Dinner Buffet will surely please your palate. There will be live entertainment for dancing or just easy listening. We will return to the hotel once the boat docks. (DINNER CRUISE INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY TWO - MONDAY- MAY 21, 2012

We will have breakfast this morning prior to checking out. After check out we depart for Florence, Indiana to the Belterra Casino Resort and Spa for a three-night stay. There will be rest stops and lunch, on own, en route. After check in you will have the rest of the afternoon and evening free to enjoy this beautiful hotel. Dinner coupons will be provided. (BREAKFAST AND DINNER BUFFET INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY THREE - TUESDAY - MAY 22, 2012

This morning after breakfast at the hotel on TOL, we will depart for Madison, IN. Narrowly spared the wrath of Confederate raiders during the Civil War, Madison's 19th century riverside beauty is still intact. It has over 100 city blocks on the National Register of Historic Sites, and much to see on both the Indiana and Kentucky sides of the Ohio River. Upon our arrival at the Madison Visitors Center, we will have time for a rest break and an introductory video. Our step on guide will be meet us at the center for a one hour tour of the historic downtown area of Madison, which resembles a little bit of Charleston and a little bit of New Orleans. Across from the Visitors Center is the Lanier Mansion, which after our driving tour, ½ our group will tour while the other half enjoys the river, gardens, and Visitors Center. The second group will then take the tour of the mansion. J.D. Lanier was known as the man who financed Indiana's Civil War debt, this Eaton, Ohio native built a beautiful ante-bellum mansion, overlooking the Ohio River. Explore the home, and the beautiful grounds, as you relive life in the mid 1800s. Following lunch on own, there will time for shopping. For the CHOCOLHOLICS be sure to head to Cocoa Safari Chocolates. We will then board the coach for a tour of the Thomas Family Winery. Located in an 1850's era stable and carriage house, a quick jaunt from the Ohio River. We will sample a few wines and will have some shopping time. We will depart Madison and head back to Belterra. (BREAKFAST AND DINNER BUFFET INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY FOUR - WEDNESDAY- MAY 23, 2012

After breakfast this morning, we will depart Belterra and travel to Covington, KY where we will pick up our tour guide and travel to Cincinnati. Our driving tour will be throughout the Queen City where we will learn about the history of the city and its German immigrants. We will see where they filmed parts of Rain Man, Little Man Tate, Down and Out in Younkers and a Rage in Harlem. The tour will take us by the QUEEN TOWER with the tiara patterned after Lady Di's on the top, Newport Aquarium and the Peace Bell, Krohn Conservatory, the Overlook, Cincinnati Art Museum, the Ohio River stadiums and the Freedom Center and Lytle Park, Lytle Park will be a stop as well as the overlook. We will then drop our guide off and say goodbye. We will then enjoy a narrated cruise on the Ohio River will scenery of the Ohio and Kentucky shorelines - both city and country scenery. Lunch and entertainment is included on this cruise. Afterwards we will board our coach and return to Belterra. (BREAKFAST, LUNCH, AND DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY FIVE - THURSDAY - MAY 24, 2012

Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning. We will then travel through Kentucky on our way to Renfro Valley. Upon arrival we will check into our hotel for a one-night stay. You will have tickets to tour the Bittersweet Cabins and the Kentucky Hall of Fame and Museum. Dinner this evening will be on TOL in the Boarding House Restaurant followed by Front Porch Picking featuring country, bluegrass music and comedy at the Renfro Valley Entertainment Center. We will return to our hotel after the show. (BREAKFAST AND DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY SIX -FRIDAY - MAY 25, 2012

Breakfast is at the hotel this morning prior to checking out and beginning our journey home. We will have rest stops and lunch, on your own, en route. We should arrive back in Charleston around 6:30 PM. (BREAKFAST INCLUDED TODAY)
