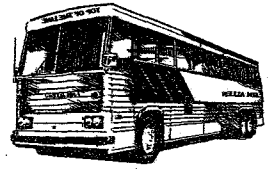

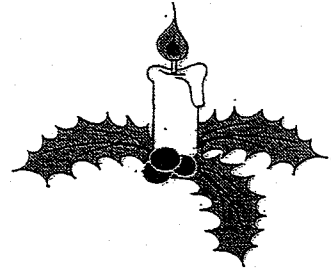

DAY ONE – THURSDAY – NOVEMBER 18, 2010

We depart Ashley Landing Mall at 6:00 A. M. and make a pickup in the Summerville. There will be rest stops and lunch, on own. Our first night we will stay in Fredericksburg, Virginia. This evening we will enjoy a “Welcome” dinner on TOL. (DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY TWO – FRIDAY – NOVEMBER 19, 2010

Our treat this morning is a full hot breakfast at the hotel before we check out of the hotel. The tour for today will start at the Fredericksburg Visitors Center for a short video. Then our Step-On Guide will take us on a tour of the historic city of Fredericksburg. We will make special stops for tours of the Mary Washington House where George Washington grew up, and the Rising Sun Tavern. After our tour we will depart for Lancaster, PA. There will be rest stops and lunch, on own, en route. DAY THREE – SATURDAY – NOVEMBER 20, 2010

She will show us many interesting sights and tell us some true stories about the Amish in this part of Pennsylvania. We will have time for lunch, on own, and shopping at the Kitchen Kettle Village. In the Cathedral Room is the Stalacpipe Organ, which is purported to be the world’s largest musical instrument. After our tour we will check into the Natural Bridge Inn. DAY FIVE – MONDAY – NOVEMBER 22, 2010

This morning we will be treated to breakfast, on TOL. This is the last day of our trip. We will travel through the countryside of Virginia and North Carolina before entering South Carolina and then home to Charleston. We will have rest stops and lunch, on own, enroute. We should arrive in Charleston around 6:00 pm. (BREAKFAST INCLUDED TODAY)
