DAY ONE – SUNDAY – OCTOBER 17, 2010

We will depart Ashley Landing Mall at 6:45 AM this morning with a pick-up in Summerville. There will be rest stops and lunch, on own, en route to Fredericksburg, Virginia for our first night. We will enjoy a “Welcome” dinner at the hotel this evening on TOTL. (DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY TWO – MONDAY – OCTOBER 18, 2010

After breakfast at the hotel on TOTL we will journey through Maryland, Delaware and into New Jersey. Lunch will be on your own with some time for shopping at The Washington Street Mall in Cape May, New Jersey. At the southeasternmost tip of the state, Cape May is one of the oldest seashore resorts on the Atlantic Coast. Cape May was designated a national historic landmark in 1976. After-lunch we will pick-up our step-on guide for a narrated driving tour of the area to include Victorian Cape May with its ginger-bread Victorian architecture, Cape May Point and Cape May Lighthouse, where you will have some wonderful photo opportunities. Cape May Lighthouse was erected in 1859. If you are feeling really adventurous, for an additional fee, you can climb the 99 steps to the top of the lighthouse! Our next stop will be at Sunset Beach where you can search for some “Cape May Diamonds” (quartz pebbles that are smoothed out by the tides). After our tour we will drop our guide and head for Atlantic City, New Jersey for a two-night stay. We have reservations at one of the luxurious casino hotels – Trump Taj Mahal, located on the famous “Boardwalk”. After check in you will have the rest of the evening free. You will be given a buffet dinner coupon good for either tonight or tomorrow night and \$20.00 in coin play in the casino. (FULL HOT BREAKFAST AND DINNER COUPON INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY THREE – TUESDAY – OCTOBER 19, 2010

Today is a free day for you to do as you please. Take a leisurely stroll – or a “rolling chair” ride to explore and experience Atlantic City’s world-famous Boardwalk (it was the first one ever built). A self-guided tour brochure is available at the visitor information center at the Mississippi Avenue side of Boardwalk Hall on the Boardwalk. The free Atlantic City Historical Museum and Atlantic City Art Center on Garden Pier (New Jersey Avenue) and the world-famous Steel Pier are just a few of the activities lining the Boardwalk. Don’t forget to take a stroll along the beach!! Be sure and bring your camera; the Boardwalk offers many unique photo opportunities. Have dinner on your own at one of the many restaurants on the Boardwalk that offer spectacular views of the Atlantic Ocean. In the evening Atlantic City offers a variety of exciting entertainment, from headline concerts in historic Boardwalk Hall to revue and comedy shows at the exciting casinos. After a night of fabulous entertainment, why not try your luck at one of the action packed casinos. (ALL MEALS ON OWN TODAY)

DAY FOUR – WEDNESDAY – OCTOBER 20, 2010

This morning after breakfast on your own we must check out and leave all of the glitz and glamour of Atlantic City behind. Today we travel to Philadelphia, PA. At the ITC building, we will board a historic trolley for a 90-minute tour of Center City Philadelphia with a 30-minute stop. Our guide will provide a wealth of interesting and fun facts about the city’s history, attractions, and architecture. After our tour, you will have lunch on own and be able to experience all that Philadelphia has to offer. Hit the cobblestone streets and awaken your inner explorer in the city that embraces past and progress. Treat your senses to bustling open-air markets and art that inspires in the city’s eclectic galleries. Watch history come to life at the Liberty Bell Center. After an interesting day, we will depart and check into our hotel. Dinner will

be on your own. The rest of the evening you are free to relax or adjacent to our hotel is the King of Prussia Mall-the nation's largest retail shopping mall. (ALL MEALS ON OWN TODAY)

DAY FIVE – THURSDAY – OCTOBER 21, 2010

After the tour we will have time for lunch on own and browsing at the Encampment Store and Canteen. We will depart from Valley Forge and head for Boiling Springs, PA, check into our hotel, Allenberry Resort Inn & Playhouse. Some of the notables that got their start on the big marquee – John Travolta, Eileen Brennan, John McMartin, Ruth Maynard, John Stratton, Roy Scheider and Shelley Berman are just a few that got their start at the Allenberry Playhouse. We will have time to relax, and freshen up before dinner (TOTL). Our evening show tonight will be "Over the River and Through the Woods." This comedy explores family relationships when grandparents try with hilarious results to keep their grown grandson from moving away from New Jersey. (BREAKFAST AND DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY SIX – FRIDAY – OCTOBER 22, 2010

After breakfast at the hotel, we will check out and depart for Wytheville, VA. There will be rest stops, lunch on own, en route.
