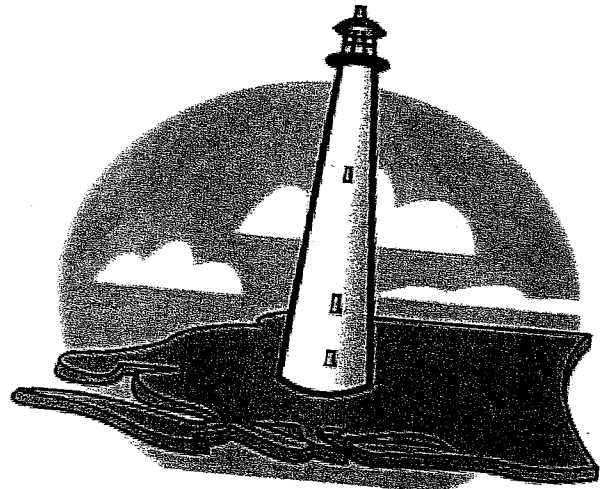

DAY ONE – SATURDAY – OCTOBER 2, 2010

We will depart Ashley Landing Plaza at 5:45 A.M. this morning to begin our Cape Cod Tour with a pick up in Summerville at 6:00 AM. The fall foliage should be beginning to turn colors as we travel through North Carolina and Virginia into Maryland. There will be rest stops and lunch, on own, en route to Edgewood, Maryland. Dinner will be at our hotel tonight on TOL. (DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY TWO – SUNDAY – OCTOBER 3, 2010

Breakfast is included at our hotel before we depart for Connecticut for a one-night stay at a place that's easy to reach and impossible to match – Foxwood's Casino Resort. The resort, owned by a Mashantucket Pequot Tribal Nation, features five spectacular casinos featuring over 5,800 of the loosest slots and 350 of the hottest tables! Everyone will have a dinner coupon and a \$15 Keno Coupon. (BREAKFAST AND DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY THREE – MONDAY – OCTOBER 4, 2010

A full breakfast buffet is available this morning prior to checking out and traveling the short distance to Mystic, CT. We will arrive at Mystic Seaport Museum for a morning of discovering New England's Maritime history. Mystic Seaport – The Museum of America and the Sea – is the nation's leading maritime museum. Explore American maritime history first-hand. View historic ships, stroll through a re-created 19<sup>th</sup>-century coastal village or watch a working preservation shipyard in action. This well established museum was founded in 1929. We will enjoy some time for lunch, on own, in the nearby Mystic Village Marketplace. After lunch we travel to Cape Cod and arrive in Hyannis, MA for a three-night stay. Enjoy a lobster dinner on TOL tonight. (BREAKFAST AND DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY FOUR – TUESDAY – OCTOBER 5, 2010

Enjoy a continental breakfast at the hotel this morning before meeting our local guide to begin a full day of touring the Cape. We will start with a tour of Hyannis including the John F. Kennedy Memorial, the Korean War Memorial, Hyannisport and a view of St. Francis Xavier Church. Next we will travel along scenic Route 6A driving through colonial villages filled with wonderful examples of New England architecture. We will view the Eastham Windmill, a Cape Cod Lighthouse and visit the Cape Cod National Seashore Visitors Center. Lunch will be on your own today. As we continue our travels the landscape dramatically changes as you approach "Land's End" – Provincetown. You will be surrounded on all sides by the ocean and sand dunes and a landscape dotted with small cottages. "P-town" is a unique destination with a rich history that combines a love of the sea and the arts. Walk along the narrow streets filled with restaurants, shops and galleries and have fun! Dinner with entertainment will be on TOL tonight. (CONTINENTAL BREAKFAST AND DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

## DAY FIVE – WEDNESDAY – OCTOBER 6, 2010

Our day begins with a continental breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast we depart the hotel and travel to Ocean Street in Hyannis to the Hy-Line Dock to board a traditional ferry to the island of Martha's Vineyard. Upon arrival you will board a local bus for a Down Island Tour. Travel throughout the villages on the island learning about the local history and lifestyles of the islanders. There will be free time for lunch, on own, and shopping in the historic whaling port of Edgarton. Complete your day on the island with a walking tour of the "Gingerbread Cottages" at the Methodist Campground in Oak Bluffs. We will depart on the afternoon ferry for our return to Hyannis. Dinner will be on TOL tonight at a local restaurant. (CONTINENTAL BREAKFAST AND DINNER INCLUDED TONIGHT)

## DAY SIX – THURSDAY – OCTOBER 7, 2010

A continental breakfast is included this morning before we travel east to Boothbay Harbor, Maine. There will be rest stops and lunch, on own en route. This city is the boating capital of Maine. We will have some free time to browse and shop before our harbor cruise. We will see lighthouses and learn the harbor history as we cruise. After check in at our waterfront lodging you will have time to freshen up before we depart for dinner - a Downeast Lobster Bake, with all the trimmings, will be prepared by the volunteer firemen and their wives, and served in an old island Playhouse, home to a theater group. (BREAKFAST AND DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

## DAY SEVEN – FRIDAY – OCTOBER 8, 2010

Breakfast is available this morning before we check out and head towards home. Our travels today will take us to Middletown, NY for a one-night stay. There will be rest stops and lunch, on own, en route. After check in you will be on your own for dinner this evening. (BREAKFAST INCLUDED TODAY)

## DAY EIGHT – SATURDAY – OCTOBER 9, 2010

Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning. We will then depart for Fredericksburg, Virginia. We hope to see some more of the beautiful fall colors as we drive through New York and Pennsylvania. There will be rest stops and lunch, on own, en route. After check in you will have time to relax and freshen up before enjoying dinner on TOL at our hotel this evening. (BREAKFAST AND DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

## DAY NINE – SUNDAY – OCTOBER 10, 2010 (10/10/10)

After breakfast, on TOL, we will check out of our hotel and depart for home with fond memories of our Cape Cod Tour. There will be rest stops and lunch, on own, en route. We should arrive back in Charleston around 5:00 PM. (BREAKFAST INCLUDED TODAY)
