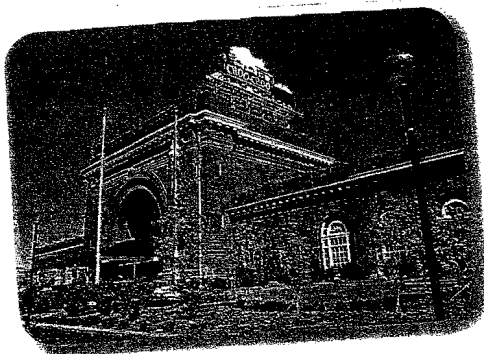
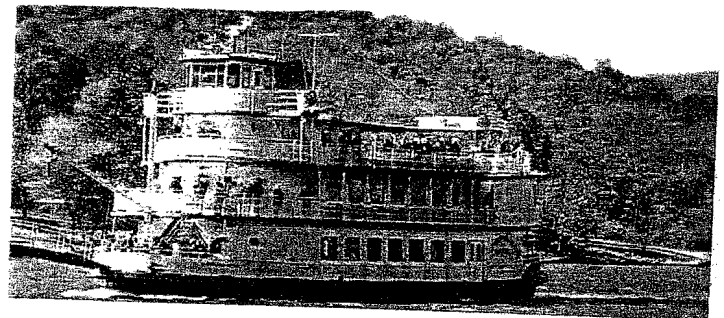
Tennessee Valley Railroad Autumn Leaf Excursion

The Tennessee Valley Railroad "Autumn Leaf Special"



DAY ONE - FRIDAY - OCTOBER 15, 2010

We will leave Ashley Landing Mall at 6:45 AM this morning for our Autumn Leaf Special Trip to Chattanooga, TN. There will be rest stops and lunch, on own, as we travel to Chattanooga for a two-night stay. This afternoon we will check in at the Chattanooga Choo Choo. Built around the historic 1909 train station and listed on the National Register for Historic Preservation, the Chattanooga Choo Choo covers 24 acres. It combines the luxuries of today with the memories of a bygone era. After check in you will have time to explore or relax before departing for dinner. This evening we will have dinner and a cruise on the Tennessee River aboard the Southern Belle Riverboat. The Captain's *Gradito* Dinner Buffet will surely please your palate. There will be live entertainment for dancing or just easy listening. We will return to the hotel once the boat docks. (DINNER CRUISE INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY TWO - SATURDAY - OCTOBER 16, 2010

This morning after an early breakfast at the hotel on TOL, we depart for the Grand Junction Railway Station for a travel experience straight from the "Golden Age of American Railroading" where we will board our train for a spectacular trip to view the Autumn Leaves. The train will be powered by an authentic full-sized steam locomotive (with diesel assist). The vintage train follows an historic route from Grand Junction Station in Chattanooga to Chickamauga, Georgia; crossing the state line in Rossville. Fall colors are usually a highlight outside the train, while a dining car luncheon (included), complete with chinaware, is served inside the dining car "Travelers Fare". Included in the day will be two photo runbys and two layovers. One of the layovers will be in Chickamauga for two hours, while a shorter layover will be at Wilder Tower in Chickamauga National Military Park (Civil War Battlefield) for approximately 45 minutes. You will enjoy the railroad history and Civil War points of interest presented during the day plus the spectacular fall colors. We arrive back at the train station around 5:15 PM. Upon arrival back at the hotel you will have time to freshen up before dinner at the hotel on TOL at the "Station House Restaurant" famous for their singing waiters! (BREAKFAST, LUNCH AND DINNER INCLUDED TODAY)

DAY THREE - SUNDAY - OCTOBER 17, 2010

This morning after breakfast at the hotel on TOL, it is time to head home to Charleston. There will be rest stops and lunch, on TOL, at one of our favorite restaurants - The Blue Willow Inn in Historic Social Circle, Georgia. We should arrive back in Charleston around 5:30 PM with wonderful memories of Chattanooga and the spectacular Autumn Leaf excursion. (BREAKFAST AND LUNCH INCLUDED TODAY)

Thus, we reserve the right to take individuals off trips at any point if said person disrupts the tour for others. The balance of that person's tour would be refunded.
